## AREA COMPANIES ASKED TO HELP DELIVER MEALS ON WHEELS

For the eleventh year, employees of Citi corporation helped “Deliver Dallas” by delivering Meals on Wheels in Dallas County for the Visiting Nurse Association. The annual event aims to publicize the critical need for Meals on Wheels volunteer drivers and challenge other companies to become involved.

Because of a shortage of volunteers, the Visiting Nurse Association must hire drivers to deliver nearly 65 percent of the 3,500 Meals on Wheels it provides to homebound elderly and disabled individuals in Dallas County each day. Over 900 Citi employees volunteered to deliver those meals on June 10.

“A volunteer driver delivering just one Meals on Wheels route on a single day saves the Visiting Nurse Association enough money to furnish someone with a home-delivered meal for an entire week,” stated Robert Carpenter, the organization’s president and chief executive officer.
