A NIGHT AT THE THEATER BENEFITS VNA

Theater lights shined brightly on the Visiting Nurse Association's "Wheels for Meals and More" gala held February 28, 2010 at the Dee and Charles Wylie Theatre in the AT&T Performing Arts Center in Dallas.

Over 350 guests attended the "Classic Evening of Caring" fundraiser to benefit the Visiting Nurse Association's Meals on Wheels, home care, and hospice programs. The evening included a reception, dinner, presentations, and live auction. Over \$450,000 was raised from the event.

"Wheels For Meals and More" was co-chaired by Nita and Cullum Clark, with Bess and Ted Enloe serving as honorary co-chairs of the event. The presenting sponsor for the gala was Bank of America.

The name "Wheels For Meals and More" highlights the services provided by the Visiting Nurse Association that are "driven" to patients' homes. Last year, the Visiting Nurse Association prepared 1,100,567 meals for home delivery, made over 44,000 home care visits, and provided more than 43,000 days of hospice care.
