

“WHEELS FOR MEALS” IS A WINNER FOR VNA

Engines roared at the Visiting Nurse Association’s “Wheels For Meals and More” fundraising gala on March 30, 2008 at Park Place Porsche in Dallas. The event raised over \$344,000 to support the Visiting Nurse Association’s Meals on Wheels, home care, and hospice programs. In addition, the fundraiser will help the Visiting Nurse Association complete the rebuilding of its headquarters in Dallas, which housed the Meals on Wheels kitchen before it was destroyed by a fire in 2005.

“Wheels For Meals and More” was co-chaired by Marianne Staubach and Mary Templeton. Mrs. Staubach is a board member of the Visiting Nurse Association and long-time Meals on Wheels volunteer. The presenting sponsor for the gala was Bank of America.

The evening included a reception, dinner, program, and live auction. NASCAR Sprint Cup Series Car No. 96 DLP® HDTV Toyota, sponsored by Texas Instruments, was on display at the event.

The “Wheels For Meals and More” theme of the gala underscored that services provided by the Visiting Nurse Association are “driven” to patients’ homes. In fiscal year 2007, the Visiting Nurse Association prepared 856,918 meals for home delivery and made over 100,000 home visits to provide home health and hospice care.
