Information Collection and Use

VNATexas.org collects two types of information from users:

Impersonal data such as conventional log files from the server that has allowed you to access this site are gathered so we can monitor, assess and maintain the site more effectively. This information does not identify the individual user, rather it allows us to know, for example, how many people have accessed our web site or pages on the site. As a result, we are able to correct problems and improve or update web site content to better meet your needs.

Personal information such as your name, address, e-mail address or other similar information is gathered only when you provide them to us. By doing this, you consent to the collection, use and storage of this information by VNA of Texas. Your personal information is stored in a secured electronic database.

When making a donation, VNA of Texas provides you the opportunity to “unsubscribe” or opt-out of receiving mailed or e-mailed communications. Our on-line donation page is a service provided by Blackbaud, Inc., which is linked to our website and uses SSL encryption, an industry standard secure technology. VNA of Texas will not intentionally disclose, sell, trade, rent or otherwise reveal your personal information to any third party without your permission, subject to the following exceptions: (i) VNA of Texas may disclose your contact information as required or permitted by applicable laws, rules or regulations (ii)VNA of Texas may share this information with Blackbaud, Inc. or the financial institutions that make it possible for us to process and acknowledge your gift. Security

VNA of Texas has implemented accepted standards of technology and operation security in order to protect personally-identifiable information from loss, misuse, alteration or destruction. Use of Cookies

VNATexas.org uses cookies to automate the process of logging on to certain areas of the web site. A cookie is a small data file stored on your computer that contains a single, randomly assigned user ID number. By recognizing this ID number, Vnatexas.org can automatically provide you with the personalized content you requested. Cookies can neither read any other files on your computer, nor damage your computer. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies. If you prefer, you can set your browser to refuse cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent.
