Announcing the VNA Hospice House

We're excited to announce the opening of the first and only Hospice House in North Texas. Providing a safe, compassionate place for seriously ill patients without adequate housing, caregivers, or resources to spend their final days with dignity. Scheduled to open in Dallas in 2027, this five-bedroom home will offer 24-hour care and the full benefits of hospice in a warm, supportive environment.

VNA Meals on Wheels Continues to Grow

VNA Texas continues to expand its Meals on Wheels program each year to meet the needs of more North Texas seniors than ever before. In 2025, the program served 7,419 unduplicated clients—a 9.8% increase from 2024—delivering not only nutritious meals but also daily connections that help seniors age safely at home.
