years; and

WHEREAS:

Volunteers for Meals on Wheels programs in Richardson are the backbone of the program and they not only deliver nutritious meals to seniors and individuals with disabilities who are at significant risk of hunger and isolation, but also caring concern and

attention to their welfare; and

WHEREAS:

Meals on Wheels programs in Richardson provide nutritious meals to seniors throughout Richardson that help them maintain their health and independence, thereby helping to prevent unnecessary falls, hospitalizations and/or premature

institutionalization; and

WHEREAS:

Meals on Wheels programs in Richardson provide a powerful opportunity for social connection for seniors to help combat the negative health effects and economic consequences of loneliness and isolation; and

WHEREAS:

The senior population is increasing substantially, and action is needed now to support local Meals on Wheels programs through federal, state, and local funding; volunteering; donations, and raising awareness to ensure these vital services can continue to be delivered for years to come.

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, Paul Voelker, Mayor of the City of Richardson, Texas, do hereby proclaim March 2023 as:
